Dear Resident and/or Property Owner:

The City of Laguna Beach has completed the survey of residents and property owners to ascertain their preference for a pedestrian improvement along Temple Hills Drive. We received 170 responses.

- 86 respondents preferred the raised sidewalk alternative
- 47 respondents preferred the at-grade pedestrian/bicycle facility
- 37 respondents preferred keeping the existing conditions

Based on this information, the consultant will now begin to produce more detailed plans of the raised sidewalk alternative. Each property the sidewalk will front will receive letter in the next couple of weeks detailing the location of the sidewalk along their frontage and any potential disruptions to private improvements within the public right-of-way.

In addition, everyone in the area will receive a notice several weeks prior to the project going to the Design Review Board.
